Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services during Jul-Jan

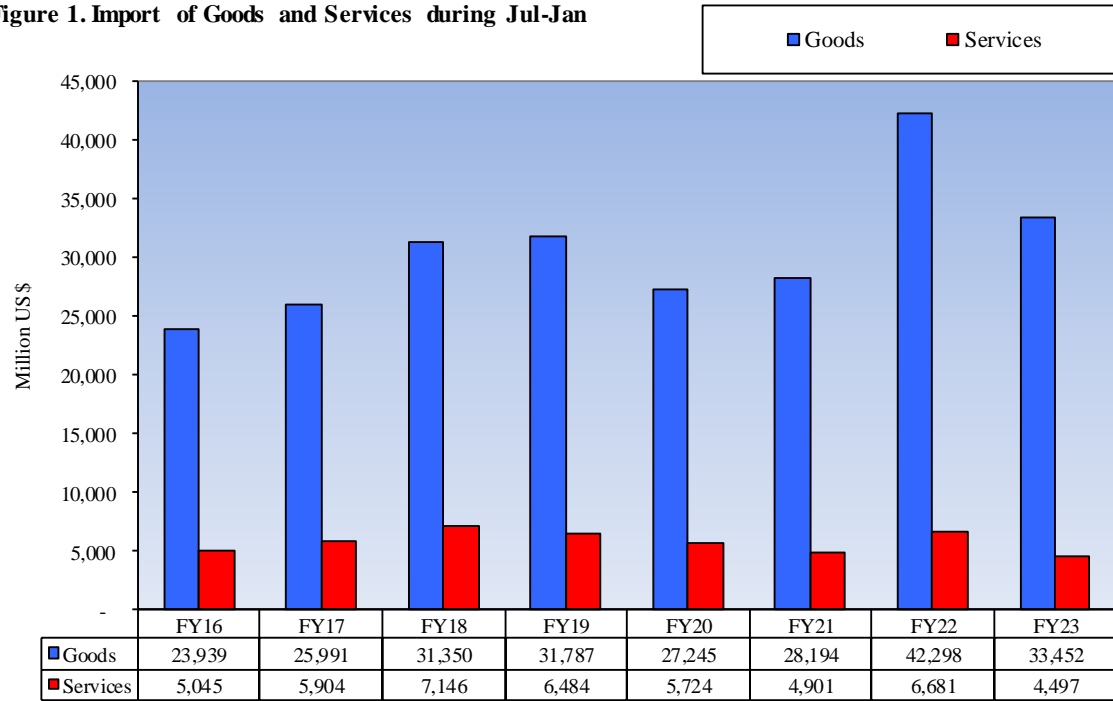


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services during Jul-Jan

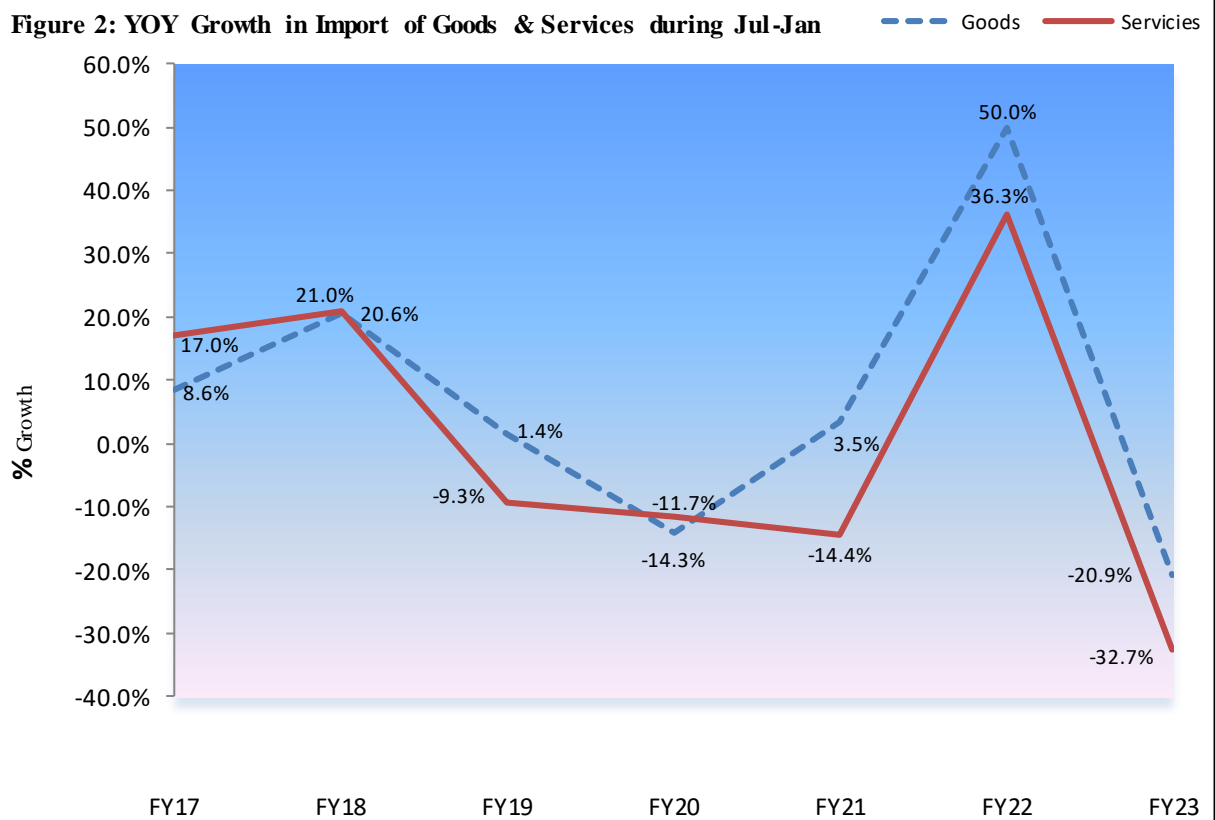

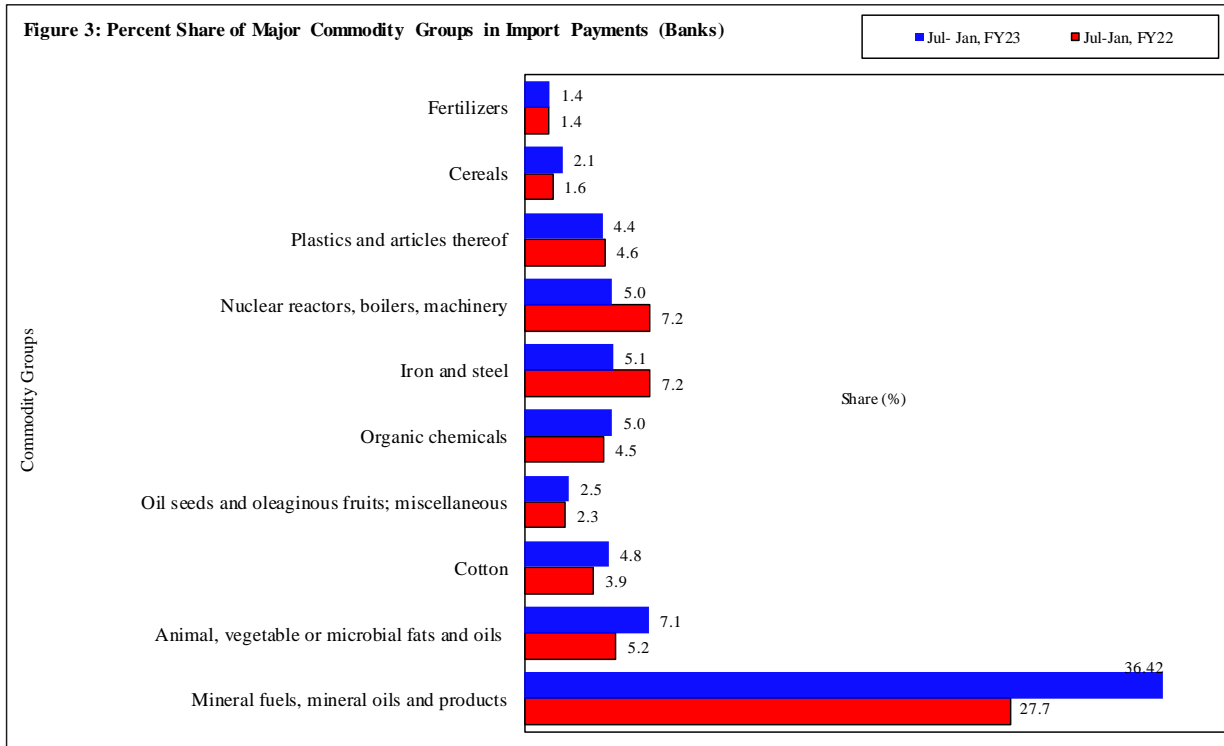

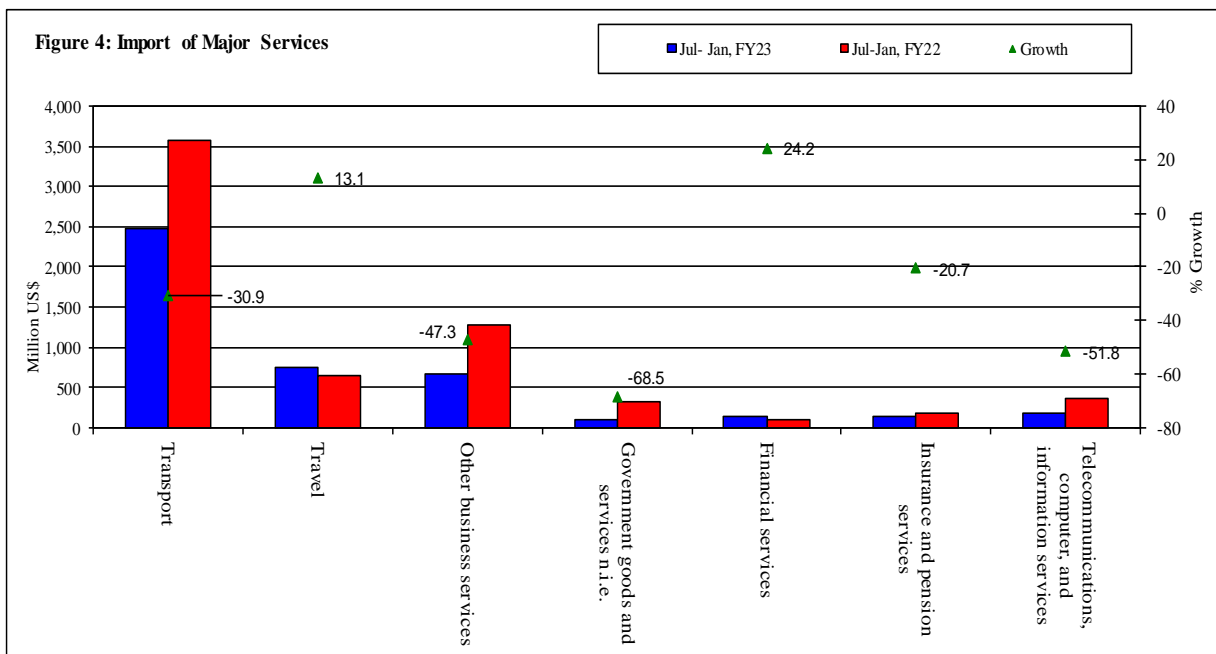
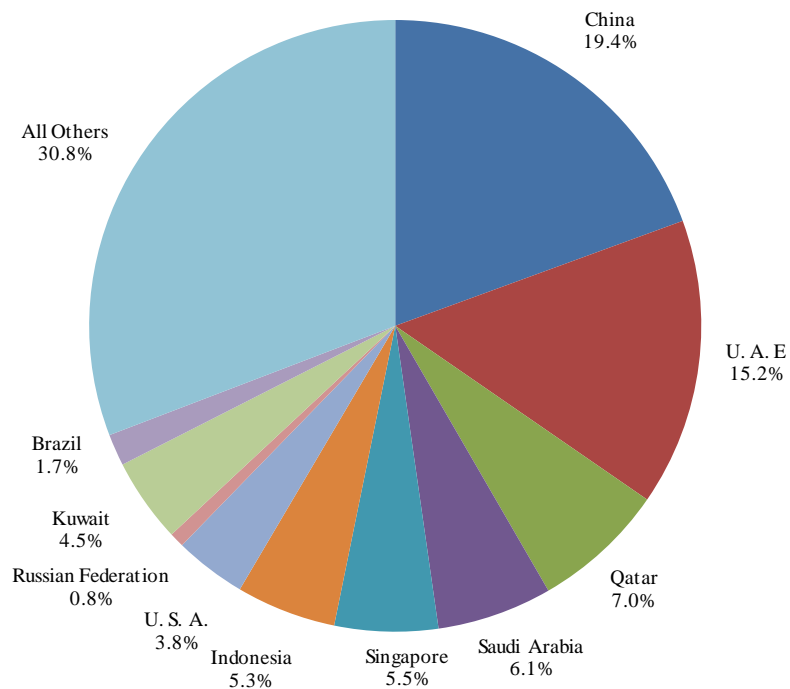
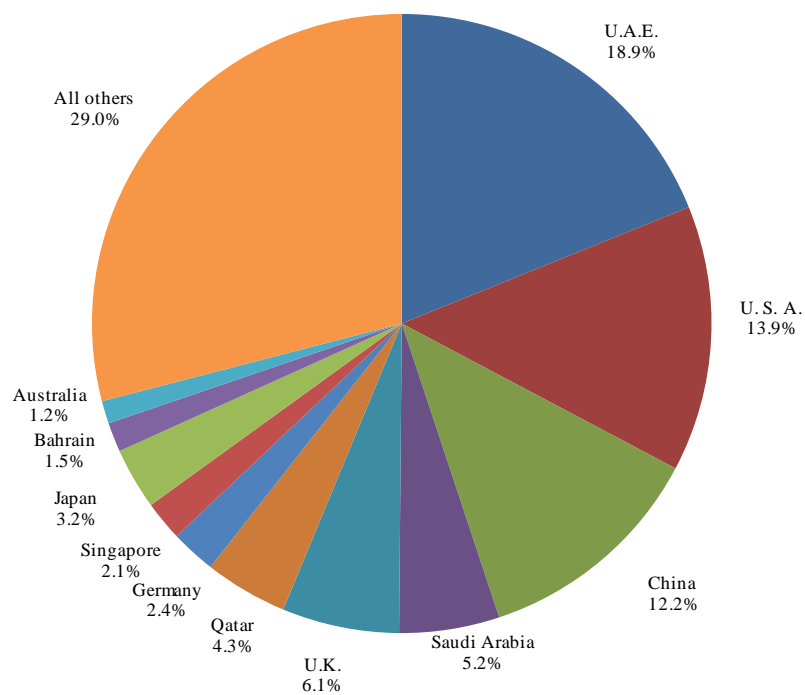


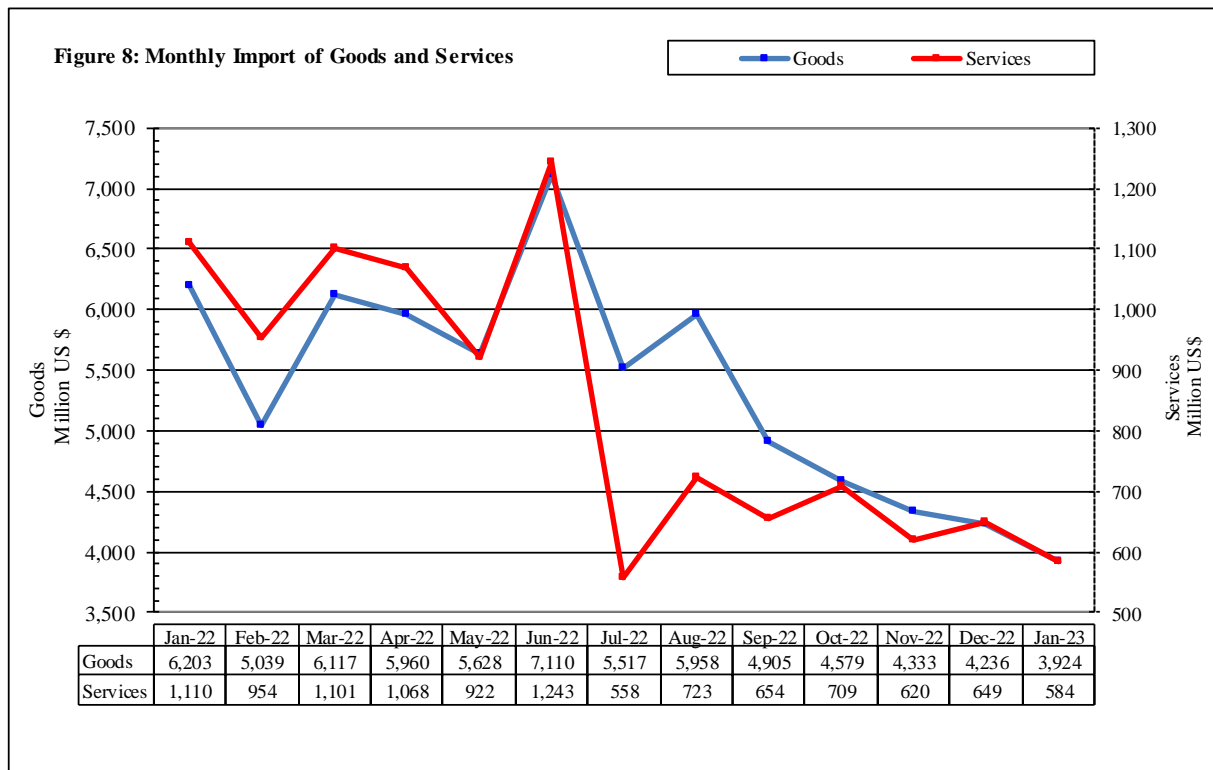
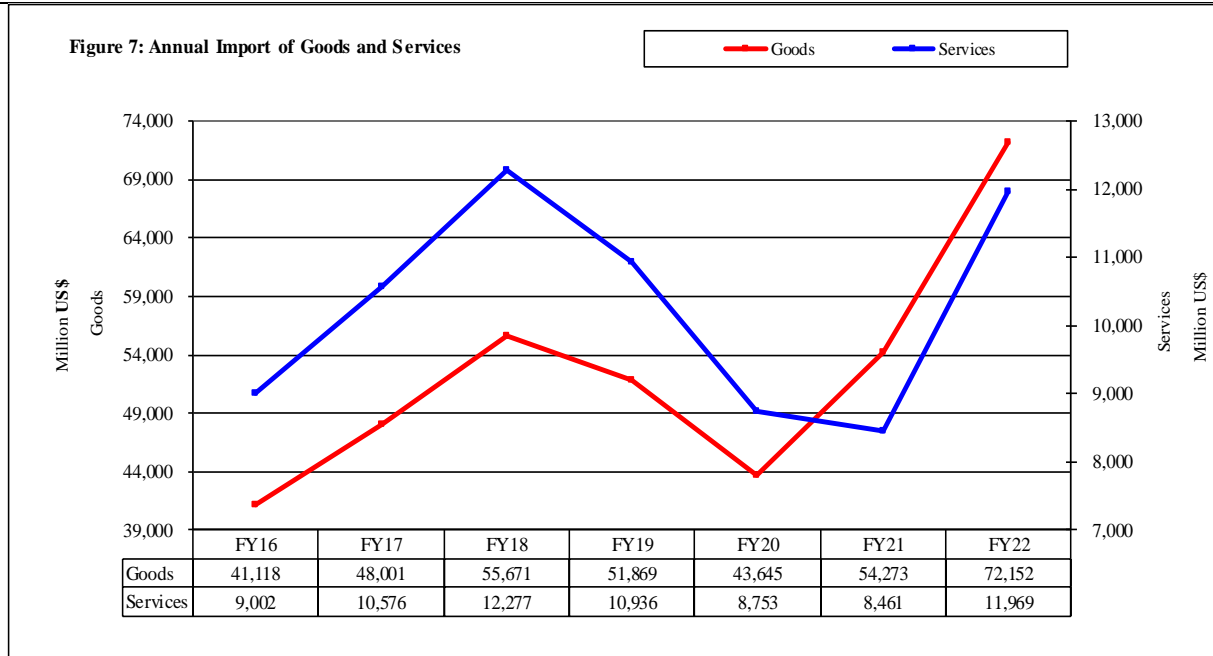
Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul-Jan, FY23
