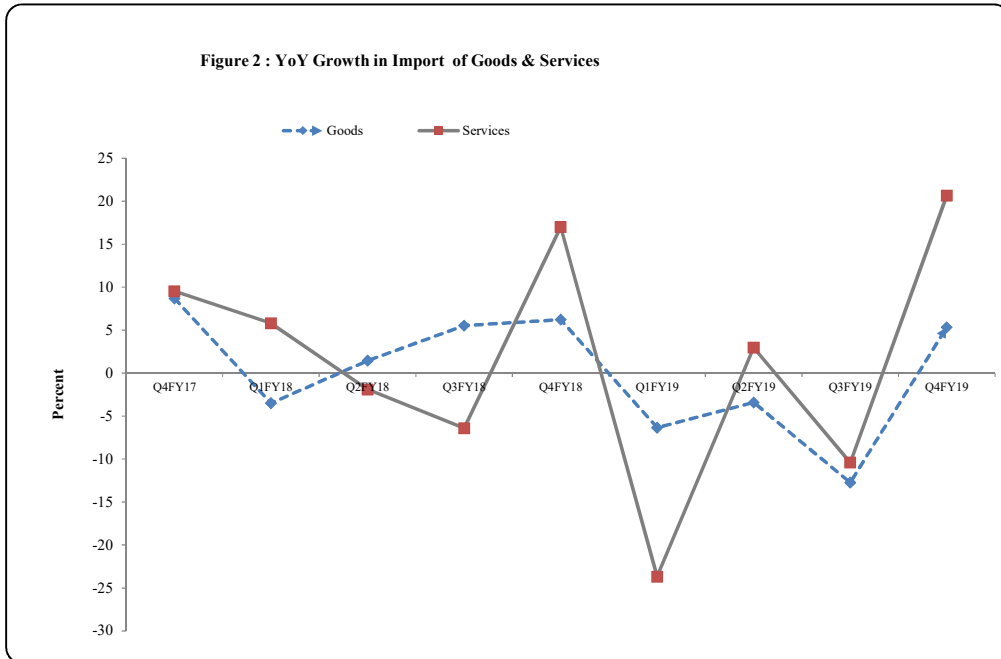
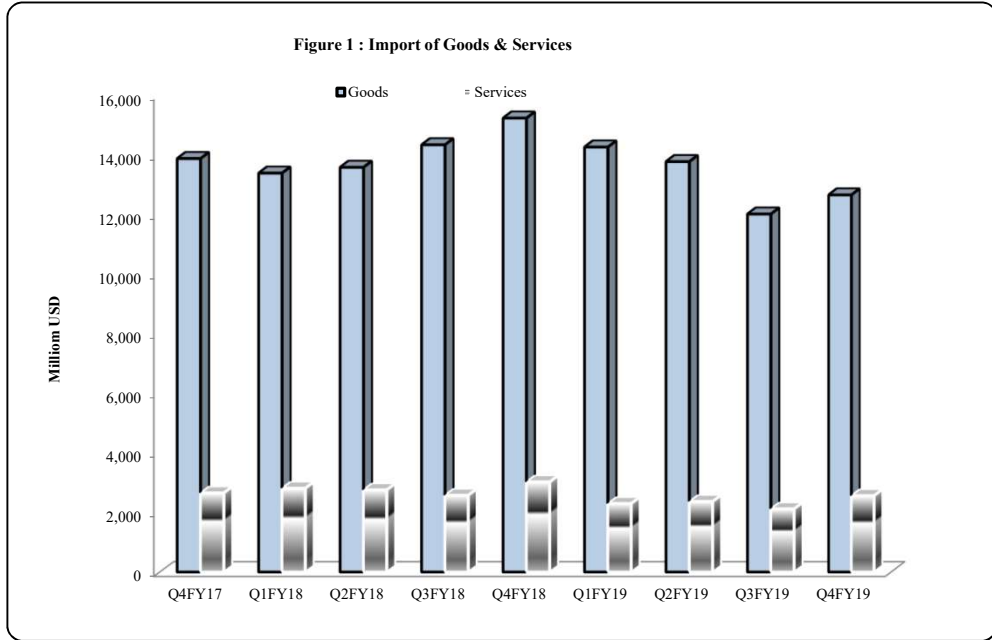
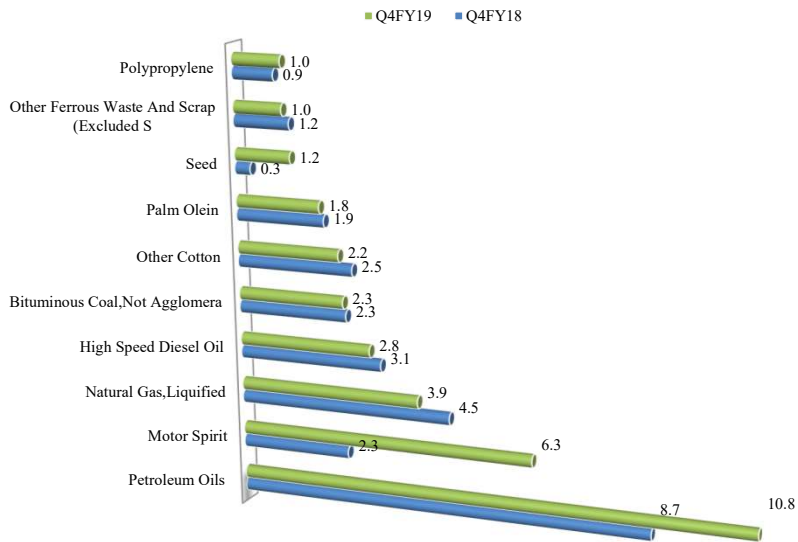


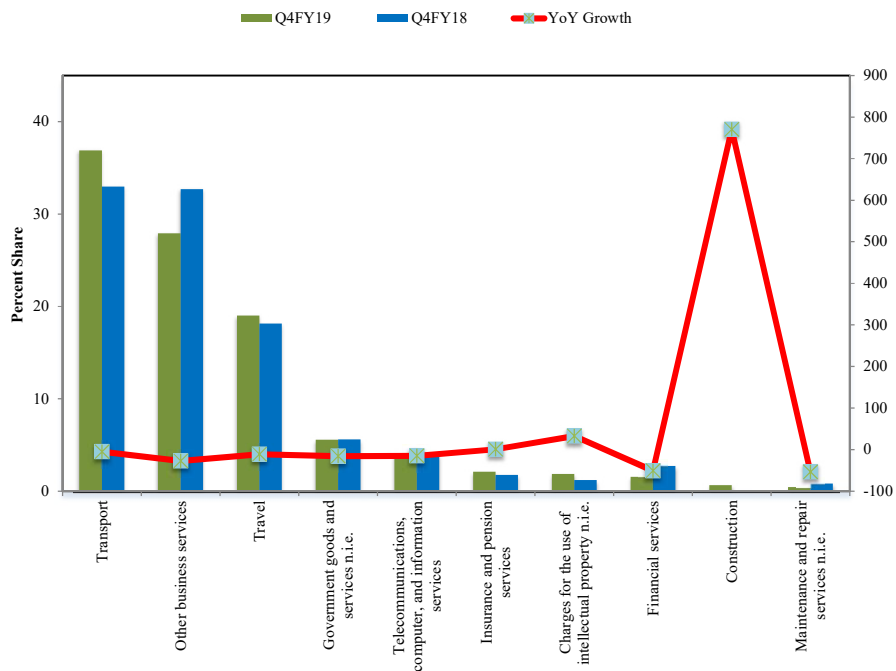

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods (Banks)

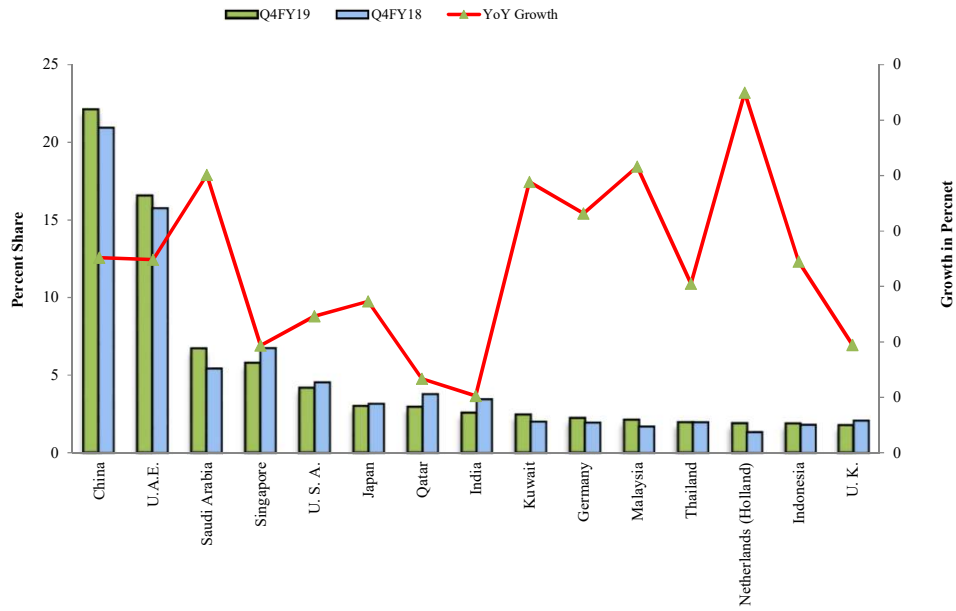
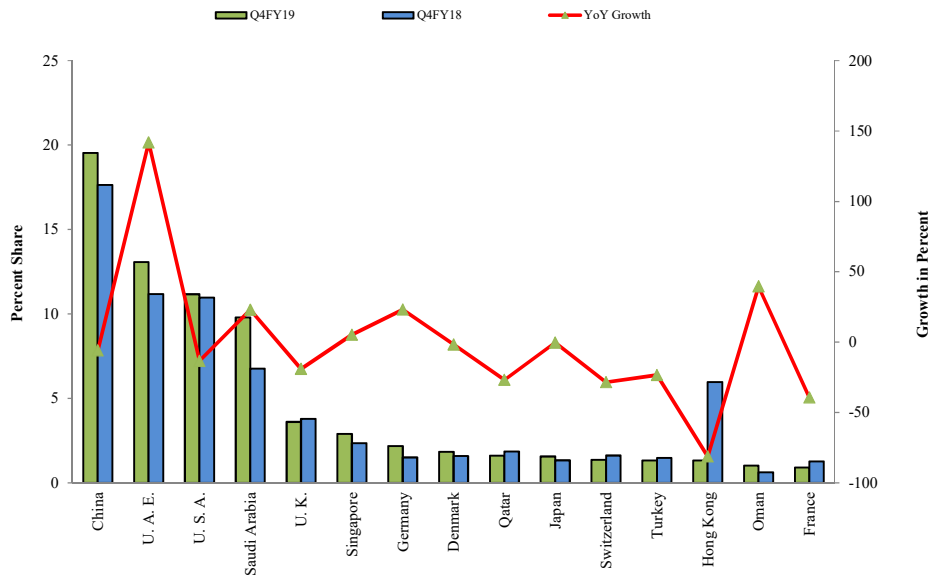


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Import of Services



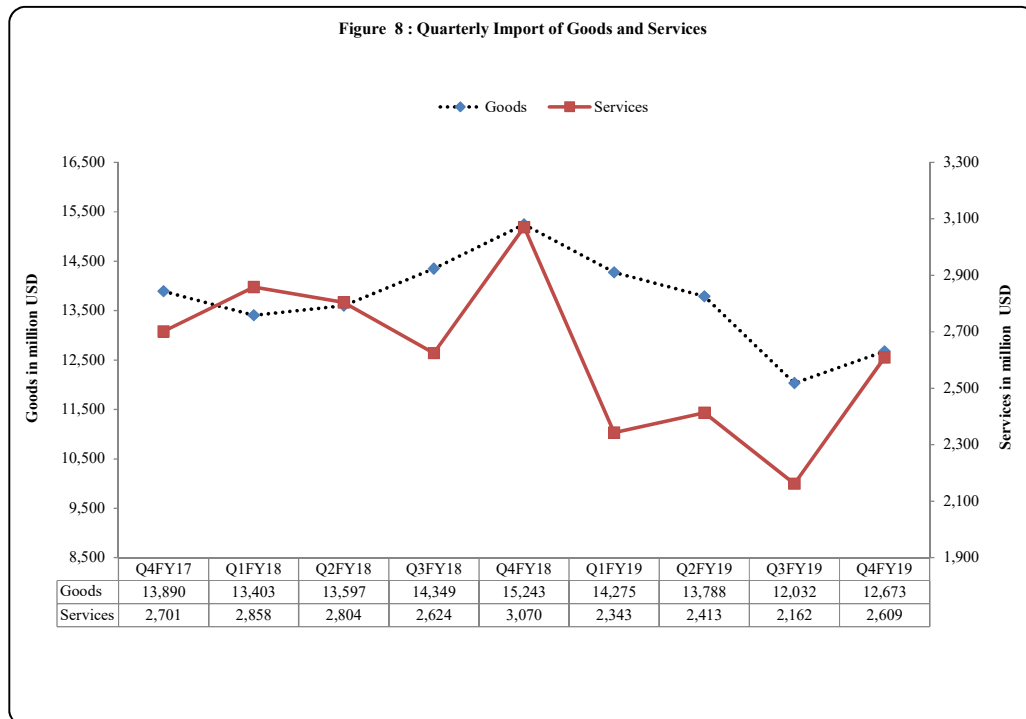
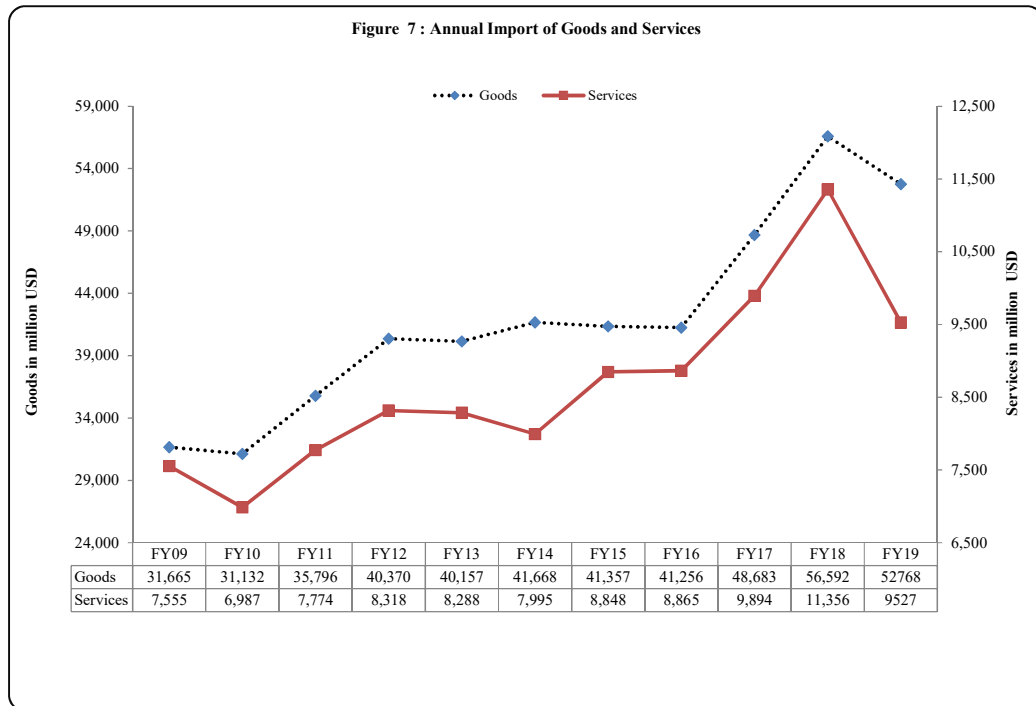
