Hyderabad

Hyderabad is the second largest city of Sindh Province and an important contributor in the country's economy, having industries such as cement, textiles, sugar, paper, mirror-manufacturing, soap, pottery, plastics, tanneries, etc. Hyderabad is also famous for ornamental bangles, Rabri (a dessert prepared with milk), Resham Gali Bazaar, Ranikot Fort, Rani Bagh and Sindh Museum.

State Bank of Pakistan started its functions in Hyderabad in 1969 as an Exchange Control Unit in a small building (Al-KHALIL) situated at Qazi Abdul Quayyum Road Hyderabad. Full-fledge operations started in the year 1971, while office shifted to a newly, purpose built building at Thandi Sarak Hyderabad in May 2000 which was inaugurated by former Governor State Bank of Pakistan, Dr. Ishrat Hussain.
