4. The application form along with legible valid copy of CNIC and cheque / pay order must be submitted to SBP BSC counter at least 6 working days before the start of shut period of the desired National Prize Bonds.
5. The signatures of the applicant on the prescribed application form should be as per legible valid copy of CNIC furnished.
6. Separate application form will be required against each cheque received. Submission of multiple cheques along with a single application is not allowed.
7. The applicant must be personally present at the time of receipt of National Prize Bonds.
8. The date of issuance of bonds shall be the date, when the applicant visits concerned SBP BSC office to receive them. Hence, the responsibility to collect the bonds on time lies on applicant.
