## **SECTION II: INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITBs)**



## **Section II. Instructions to Bidders (ITBs)**

		T	A. Introduction
1.	Scope of Application	1.1	The Procuring Agency (PA), as indicated in the <b>Bid Data Sheet (BDS)</b> invites Bids for the provision of Goods as specified in the BDS and Section V - Technical Specifications & Schedule of Requirements. The successful Bidders will be expected to supply and install the machine within the specified period and timeline(s) as stated in the BDS.
2.	Sources of Funds	2.1	Source of funds is referred in Clause-2 of Invitation to Bids.
3.	Eligible Bidders	3.1	A Bidder may be natural person, company or firm or public or semi-public agency of Pakistan or of any foreign country, or any combination of them with a formal existing agreement (on Judicial Papers) in the form of a joint venture, consortium, or association. In the case of a joint venture, consortium, or association, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the Contract in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract. The joint venture, consortium, or association shall nominate a Lead Member as nominated in the BDS, who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the joint venture, consortium, or association during the Bidding process, and in case of award of contract, during the execution of contract.
		3.2	The appointment of Lead Member in the joint venture, consortium, or association shall be confirmed by submission of a valid Power of Attorney to the Procuring Agency.
		3.3	Verifiable copy of the agreement that forms a joint venture, consortium or association shall be required to be submitted as part of the Bid.
		3.4	Any bid submitted by the joint venture, consortium or association shall indicate the part of proposed contract to be performed by each party and each party shall be evaluated (or post qualified if required) with respect to its contribution only, and the responsibilities of each party shall not be substantially altered without prior written approval of the Procuring Agency and in line with any instructions issued by the Authority.
		3.5	The invitation for Bids is open to all prospective supplier, manufacturers or authorized agents/dealers subject to any provisions of incorporation or licensing by the respective national incorporating agency or statutory body established for that particular trade or business.
		3.6	Foreign Bidders must be locally registered with the appropriate national incorporating body or the statutory body, before participating in the national/international competitive tendering with the exception of such procurements made by the foreign missions of Pakistan. For such purpose the bidder must have to initiate the registration process before the bid submission and the necessary evidence shall be submitted to the procuring agency along with their bid, however, the final award will be subject to the complete registration process.
		3.7	A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Bidders may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this Bidding process, if they:  a. are associated or have been associated in the past, directly or indirectly with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by the Procuring Agency to provide consulting services for the preparation of the design, specifications and other documents to be used for the procurement of goods and related services to be procured under this Invitation for Bids.  b. have controlling shareholders in common; or
			<ul> <li>c. receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them; or</li> <li>d. have the same legal representative for purposes of this Bid; or</li> <li>e. have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the Bid of another Bidder, or influence the decisions of the Procuring Agency regarding this Bidding process; or</li> <li>f. Submit more than one Bid in this Bidding process.</li> </ul>
		3.8	<ul> <li>A Bidder may be ineligible if — <ul> <li>a. he is declared bankrupt or, in the case of company or firm, insolvent;</li> <li>b. payments in favor of the Bidder is suspended in accordance with the judgment of a court of law other than a judgment declaring bankruptcy and resulting (in accordance with the national laws) in the total or partial loss of the right to administer and dispose of its property;</li> <li>c. legal proceedings are instituted against such Bidder involving an order suspending payments and which may result, in accordance with the national laws, in a declaration of bankruptcy or in any other situation entailing the total or partial loss of the right to administer and dispose of the property;</li> <li>d. the Bidder is convicted, by a final judgment, of any offence involving professional conduct;</li> <li>e. the Bidder is blacklisted and hence debarred due to involvement in corrupt and fraudulent practices, or performance failure or due to breach of bid securing declaration.</li> <li>f. The firm, supplier and contractor is blacklisted or debarred by a foreign country, international organization, or other foreign institutions for the period defined by them.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
		3.9	Bidders shall provide to the Procuring Agency evidence of their eligibility, proof of compliance with the

Eligible Goods and Related Services	4.1	All the goods and related services to be supplied under the contract shall have their origin in eligible source countries, and all expenditures made under the contract will be limited to such goods and services. For purpose of this Bid, ineligible countries are stated in the section-4 titled as "Eligible Countries".
		4.2	For purposes of this Clause, "origin" means the place where the goods are mined, grown, cultivated, produced, manufactured, or processed, or through manufacture, procession, or assembly, another commercially recognized article results that differs substantially in its basic characteristics from its imported
			components or the place from where the related services are/to be supplied.
		4.3	The nationality of the supplier that supplies and install the goods shall not determine the origin of the goods.
		4.4	To establish the eligibility of the Goods and the related services, Bidders shall fill the country of origin

		4.5	If so required in the <b>BDS</b> , the Bidder shall demonstrate that it has been duly authorized by the manufacturer of the goods to deliver in Pakistan (or in respective country in case of procurement by the Pakistani

#### H. MECHANISM OF BLACKLISTING

  - Involved in corrupt and fraudulent practices as defined in Rule-2 of Public Procurement Rules:
  - ii. Fails to perform his contractual obligations; and
  - iii. Fails to abide by the id securing declaration;
- 49.2 The show cause notice shall contain: (a) precise allegation, against the bidder or contractor; (b) the maximum period for which the Procuring Agency proposes to debar the bidder or contractor from participating in any public procurement of the Procuring Agency; and (c) the statement, if needed, about the intention of the Procuring Agency to make a request to the Authority for debarring the bidder or contractor from participating in public procurements of all the procuring agencies.
- 49.3 The procuring agency shall give minimum of seven days to the bidder or contractor for submission of written reply of the show cause notice.
- 49.4 In case, the bidder or contractor fails to submit written reply within the requisite time, the Procuring Agency may issue notice for personal hearing to the bidder or contractor/ authorize representative of the bidder or contractor and the procuring agency shall decide the matter on the basis of available record and personal hearing, if availed.
- 49.5 In case the bidder or contractor submits written reply of the show cause notice, the Procuring Agency may decide to file the matter or direct issuance of a notice to the bidder or contractor for personal hearing.
- 49.6 The Procuring Agency shall give minimum of seven days to the bidder or contractor for appearance before the specified officer of the Procuring Agency for personal hearing. The specified officer shall decide the matter on the basis of the available record and personal hearing of the bidder or contractor, if availed.
- 49.7 The procuring Agency shall decide the matter within fifteen days from the date of personal hearing unless the personal hearing is adjourned to a next date and in such an eventuality, the period of personal hearing shall be reckoned from the last date of personal hearing.
- 49.8 The Procuring Agency shall communicate to the bidder or contractor the order of debarring the bidder or contractor from participating in any public procurement with a statement that the bidder or contractor may, within thirty days, prefer a representation against the order before the Authority.
- 49.9 Such blacklisting or barring action shall be communicated by the procuring agency to the Authority and respective bidder or bidders in the form of decision containing the grounds for such action. The same shall be publicized by the Authority after examining the record whether the procedure defined in blacklisting and debarment mechanism has been adhered to by the procuring agency.
- 49.10 The bidder may file the review petition before the Review Petition Committee Authority within thirty days of communication of such blacklisting or barring action after depositing the prescribed fee and in accordance with "Procedure of filing and disposal of review petition under Rule-19(3) Regulations, 2021". The Committee shall evaluate the case and decide within ninety days of filing of review petition
- 49.11 The committee shall serve a notice in writing upon all respondent of the review petition. Compressor shall be centrifugal compressor type with Semi-Hermetic drive type or open drive type motor.

<u>Semi-Hermetic Drive Motors:</u> Liquid refrigerant cooled with internal thermal overload protection devices embedded in the winding of each phase

Open Drive Motors: Open drip-proof, squirrel cage, induction type motors may be provided as an alternative. If an open drive motor is provided, the manufacturer shall provide a double seal shaft seal and a five-year parts and labor warranty against any shaft seal or other compressor housing penetration leaks. Refrigerant Gas should not be flammable or should not contains any traces of flammability. Machine must have surge protection/resistance in case of high condenser temperature and/or pressure.

#### **Evaporator**

The evaporator shall be of flooded shell and tube type and/or falling film type with refrigerant in shell and water in tube. The water tubes shall be individually replaceable type. Construction shall conform to the applicable ASME Code for unfired pressure vessels; it shall be made of steel with inner rifled copper pipes, with water differential pressure switch, air bleed valve, water discharge cock, Victaulic type water connections and insulation of closed cell expanded polyurethane rubber with anti U.V. protection layer. #### Condenser

Coils shall be water cooled and chiller shall be of flooded shell and tube with refrigerant in shell and water in tube. The water tube shall be individually replaceable fabricated of copper pipes. The condenser shall have a safety valve for protection against refrigerant access pressure. The coils shall have corrosion resistance capacity. The tubes shall be cleaned, dehydrated and sealed. The assembled condenser coils shall be pressure tested at Manufacturer's recommended pressure.

#### Variable Speed Drive

A variable speed drive shall be factory installed on the chiller. The variable speed drive shall vary the compressor motor speed by controlling the frequency and voltage of the electrical power to the motor. The VFD shall be capable of 100% full load continuous output. The adaptive capacity control logic shall automatically adjust motor speed and compressor pre-rotation van position independently for maximum part-load efficiency by analyzing information fed to it by sensors located throughout the chiller. Drive shall be pulse width modulation type utilizing insulated gate bipolar transistors with a power factor of 0.95 or better at all loads and speeds. The variable speed drive shall be unit-mounted in a NEMA-1 enclosure with all power and control wiring between the drive and chiller factory installed, including power to the chiller oil pump. Field power wiring shall be a single point connection and electrical lugs for incoming power wiring shall be provided.

### SECTION VII - GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

#### 1. Definitions

- 1.1. The following words and expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:
- a) "Authority" means Public Procurement Regulatory Authority.

- d) The "Commencement Date" is the date when the Supplier shall commence execution of the contract as specified in the SCC.
- e) "Completion" means the fulfillment of the related services by the Supplier in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the contract.
- f) "Country of Origin" means the countries and territories eligible under the PPRA Rules 2004 and its corresponding Regulations as further elaborated in the SCC.
- g) The "Contract Price" is the price stated in the Letter of Acceptance and thereafter as adjusted in accordance with the provisions of the Contract.
- h) "Defective Goods" are those goods which are below standards, requirements or specifications stated by the Contract.
- i) "Delivery" means the transfer of the goods from the supplier equipment, machinery, and /or other materials which the Supplier is required to supply to the Procuring Agency under Contract.
- j) "Effective Contract date" is the date shown in the Certificate of Contract Commencement issued by the Procuring Agency upon fulfillment of the conditions precedent stipulated in GCC Clause 3.
- k) "Procuring Agency" means the person named as Procuring Agency in the SCC and the legal successors in title to this person, procuring the Goods and related service, as named in SCC.
- "Related Services" means those services ancillary to the delivery of the Goods, such as transportation and insurance, and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, initial maintenance and other such obligations of the Supplier covered under the Contract.
- m) "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract contained in this section.
- n) "Intended Delivery Date" is the date on which it is intended that the Supplier shall effect delivery as specified in the SCC.
